**Treasurers Report :** The annual report for 2003 was read . Motion by John Worsley And seconded by Al DeAndrade

**Worsley Resolution:** John Worsley spoke on a resolution regarding Insurance and Survivor Benefits. A discussion ensued and it was agreed that their will have to be a by-law change. Some suggestions were: That every member over the age of 69 would receive \$1,000.00 as a Survivor Benefit including all officers. Bill Custer was concerned about timely payments. The SFB would be controlled by the Treasurer who would have a separate account of \$15,000.00 at all time to pay the Benefactors. Monies from fund raisers and the monies we would save not paying into the Insurance Co. would support the SFB fund . A suggestion was made to have a committee for the fund. Worsley suggested that it would be too confusing to set standards into the by-laws. Al DeAndrade Suggested that we open an endowment as another way to support the fund and keep it solvent. The President will call a special meeting for more discussion on the subject and a vote.

**Golf Tournament:** The Golf tournament will be held at Triggs Golf Course on August 31, 2004. More information to follow.
